Re: Consent Order and Agreement Dated December 10, 2020

Dear Mr. Bellas:

The purpose of this correspondence is to inform the Department that Keystone has finalized an agreement with a hauler to transport waste from A+ Powerwash located in Taylor to Keystone Sanitary Landfill for disposal. As I understand the Consent Order, Keystone is required to provide the Department with a ten (10) day notice prior to commencement of this project. Please accept this as the ten (10) day notification. However, if this requirement can be waived, I believe we will be ready to start early next week. Otherwise, the project will commence January 17, 2022.

Keystone is also requesting a variance in its maximum daily tons limit. Keystone's intention is to remove this material as quickly as possible and rather than slow down the process because of tonnage restrictions, Keystone is asking DEP to waive the daily tonnage limit but only to the extent that the overage is solely the result of this cleanup. If this should occur Keystone will submit reports to the Department the next working day. These reports will clearly demonstrate the exceedance was the result of this project.
