Dear Mr. DeNaples:

DEP has reviewed the Ambient Air Monitoring Plan KSL submitted on December 9, 2021, as per condition 21 of the “Major Permit Modification – Phase III Site Development” approval issued on June 3, 2021.

DEP approves of the plan with the following clarifications:

- 1.) DEP found one error in the plan. On page 4, section 2.2 Sample Collection Schedule, 1st paragraph, KSL states that samples will be collected on a seven (7) day cycle. As per previous discussions and based on conversations with KSL representatives on January 5, 2022, DEP understands that the sampling will be conducted on a six (6) day cycle, to ensure samples are collected every day of the week.
- 2.) On January 18, 2022, KSL’s consultant (EARTHRES), contacted DEP to request approval to utilize an alternate sample collection method for Formaldehyde. The proposed alternate method (NIOSH 2016) does not require an ozone scrubber in the sample train. DEP approves this alternate method contingent upon that KSL can assure ambient air ozone levels, when the samples are collected, will not affect the results.
