

NOTICE OF NEW PAVEMENT CUT ORDINANCE
DUNMORE, PENNSYLVANIA

In an effort to ensure the quality of our roadways and help lower future maintenance costs to the Municipality on our roadways, Dunmore Borough enacted Ordinance No. 3 of 2022

Effective, April 11, 2022, this ordinance requires any work, including that performed by a public or private utility contractor, or a subcontractor of such, which performs work within the Municipality's right of way to obtain a pave cut permit. A condition of the permit is that the Borough's appointed inspector must be continuously present during the backfilling, placing of any permanent pavement, or placing/replacing of any ancillary items such as concrete sidewalks or curbs.

This work includes but is not limited to the compaction of soils placed as trench backfill temperature, thickness, and compaction of asphalt used for patching and/or paving; and quality control testing on any concrete placed.

Dunmore Borough has appointed IWDA Engineering as the inspector/testing agency to carry out all the inspection requirements in the pave cut ordinance.

Please schedule all inspections through Nicole Kira, IWDA Scheduling Coordinator at 570-878-3302. All inspection requests must be scheduled by 1pm the day prior to the start of work. In case of an emergency please provide as much notice as possible to the scheduling coordinator. IWDA does not schedule through our field technicians or schedule multiple days in advance.
