so whatever land use is out there, every
municipality, the City and the Borough have to
take care of on their own. You know, with SAPA
we get to share our land uses. So, everybody
gets something.

6 And, again, it's something that we 7 as Council have spent a ton of time going over 8 and went through it, and I'm not going to lie, 9 it's not a perfect piece of paper, but it's 10 very, very good and it's amendable. So, it's 11 things that we can fix as, you know, as things 12 change.

13 And, again, it's something that 14 everybody on this Council has worked very hard 15 on for the last, you know, at least four years 16 this group and eight years since I've been 17 around, and I'm proud to have been part of it. 18 And I think I could speak for the other six 19 members of Council saying it's something that we think is great for our borough and great for 20 21 the area as a whole.
